Lager on Draught

Pilsner Urquell Czech 4.4% £3.95

'Urquell' means "original source" and is the original golden pilsner (from Pilsen). It is characterised by its golden colour and clarity and is more strongly hopped than most pilsner beers. Its recipe dates back to 1842.

Warsteiner Germany 4.8% £3.95

Multi-award winning lager from Germany. Quite full-bodied and hoppy with tangy citrus herbal notes with a dry and lemon-hoppy finish.

Kaltenberg Germany 4.1% £3.45

Derived from the German word Helles which means light in colour, Kaltenberg HELL is a smooth, refreshing 4.1% Bavarian lager with a crisp aftertaste.

Shindigger Pils Manchester 4.1% £3.90

Pilsner with zing! Conditioned for three weeks and dry hopped with new world hops which shine over a clean malt profile.

A particularly strong, spicy aroma with a distinctive yeast flavour. It owes this distinctive flavour to a recipe dating back over 120 years!

Budweiser Budvar Czech 5% 500ml £3.70

Produced from Saaz Aroma hops, Moravian malt and soft water drawn from wells 300m deep! A lager conditioned beer with a 100 day brewing cycle. Mellow & smooth with a grassy hoppiness.

Modelo Especial Mexico 4.5% 355ml £3.05

A pilsner style lager, best served with a slice of lime. A refreshing light lager with a malt base and just a hint of corn sweetness to it. There is a faintly pungent hop spiciness, with a light bitter hop aftertaste. Great for Summer quaffing!

Peroni Nastro Azzuro Italy 5.1% 330ml £3.25

This premium quality Italian beer has been brewed in Rome since 1864. Meaning 'blue ribbon' it was named after a race-winning ocean liner in 1933.

Peroni Red Italy 4.7% 330ml £2.95

The original Italian lager. This premium, clear, golden-yellow lager is brewed using the finest spring barley malts and hops, its taste is slightly bitter. A refreshing smooth lager.

Sierra Nevada Pale Ale California 5.6% 350ml £4.65

Sierra Nevada's most popular beer. It has a deep amber color and an exceptionally full-bodied, complex character.

Timmermans Framboise Italy 4.7% 330ml £4.10

<i>Deep red in colour and very fruity on the nose, smooth & silky on the palate with a spicy and malty finish. A great beer.</i>		
Chimay White	8% 330ml	£4.95
<i>Hazy golden brown with a dramatic and powerful nose. Dense and thick on the palate with a sharp bitter chicory flavour. Still crisp & clean despite the weight and richness.</i>		
Delirium Tremens	8.5% 330ml	£5.15
<i>Strong golden complex pale ale. The painted bottle and the glass both have pink elephants and green crocodiles on, which is the result of drinking too many. A lot of warming alcohol flavours abound, along with its sweet palate.</i>		
Duvel	8.5% 330ml	£5.45
<i>A bottle-conditioned golden ale. Slightly fruity accompanied by a dry aroma. Well hopped with a modest bitter aftertaste.</i>		
Leffe	6.6% 330ml	£3.25
<i>A medium gold colour. The nose is dazzling, with aromatics of herbs and spices, resins and fruits - that of mashed banana. Bittersweet hoppy tang on the palate.</i>		
Liefman's Cuvee Brut	6% 375ml	£4.95
<i>Brewed using cherries and barley malt with natural flavour added, giving a genuine rustic aroma of cherries. Chewy mouth feel with a dry finish.</i>		
St Stefanus	7%+ 330ml	£4.75
<i>Unpasteurised! Pours very slightly cloudy with a large head. The aroma has a banana bread sweetness, a little like a wheat beer. Sweet and slightly bitter with a floral hop taste. Really good.</i>
